



Personal Property and Possession Policy[©]

The following policy is required to comply with the standards of the American Camp Association:

POSSESSION AND USE OF ALCOHOL AND DRUGS

Under no circumstance are alcoholic beverages, tobacco products, illicit drugs, firearms, weapons of any kind, fireworks, or pets allowed on the location designated for Fit2Cook4Kids camp. Food And Truth, Inc. (Fit2Cook4Kids) reserves the right to search any person's belongings if it is suspected any of these items have been brought into the camp space. A search will only be conducted if the camp director has given approval. If contraband is found it will be confiscated and given to the camp director to make determination on further action.

CAMPER USE OF PERSONAL PROPERTY

As a general policy, campers and staff may bring approved belongings at their own risk (includes yoga mats, aprons, hats, electronic devices and other personal items). Food And Truth, Inc. is not responsible or liable for loss, damage or theft of said personal property. All lost and found items should be turned into the camp staff on duty or the camp director. Any exception to this policy must be in writing and approved by the camp director.

LOST & FOUND ITEMS

All "Lost & Found" items/equipment will be held at camp until the last day of camp. All "Lost & Found" items/equipment that are not picked up by the last day of camp will be discarded or donated.
